As we conclude the 2017-18 school year, I need to remind everyone that the remaining days of school following the exams are required for attendance purposes to meet the 180 days state requirement. As such, here is our plan for those school days as prepared in collaboration with the high school faculty, student leaders, and parents of the Class of 2018 and 2019.

- **June 20, 2018 - HP Day 7:48AM - 12:22PM** - All Classes Meet including Homeroom. Students need to be on time so that locker clean up can occur and our seniors can participate in graduation rehearsal and preparations.
- **June 20, 2018, 6:00PM** - Graduation Ceremony on the Front Lawn or the Auditorium if it rains - Diplomas will be awarded on June 25th
- **June 20, 2018, 10:30 PM - June 21, 2018, 4:00AM** - Project Graduation Seniors attending Project Graduation fulfill the attendance requirement of 4 hours for June 21, 2018 and do not need to come into school during the school day. Thank you to the parents of the Class of 2019 who volunteered to chaperone and especially to the parents of the Class of 2018 for making this event possible.
- **June 21, 2018 - Teacher led Activity Day (Both Inside and Outside activities to build community)** - Students must report to period 2 classes by 8:00am for attendance (which will count towards all classes) and then will report to the activities they selected for the day with an Early Dismissal at 12:22pm
- **June 22, 2018 - Third Annual EcoFest** - Students must report to Period 2 by 8am for attendance (which will count towards all classes), an opening assembly, and then will report to homeroom to participate in a day of workshops dedicated to celebrating and protecting our environment.
- **June 25, 2018 - HP Day 7:48AM - 12:22PM** - All Classes Meet including Homeroom. Last Day for students and staff, diplomas awarded to seniors during the last periods of the day
